The first night we had happy hour by the campfire with some great munchies.

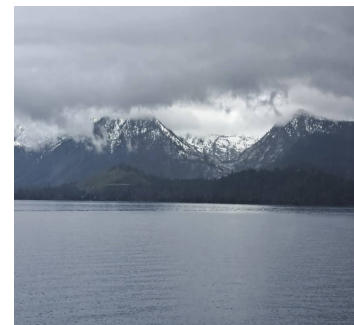
Friday a spaghetti dinner was served with salad and all of the fixings.

The few items that did not sell were either given away free at the end of the day or donated to DAV. This was another successful sale for the club.



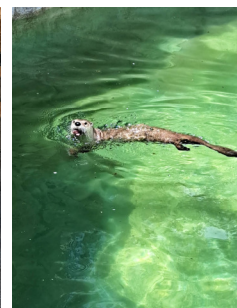
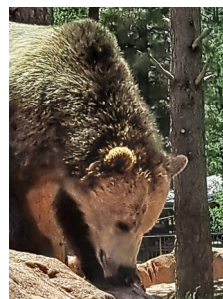
Grand Canyon Railway RV Park **June 4-8, 2026**
